#### **Essential Criteria**

- Candidates should possess fully qualified teacher status as recognised by DENI.
- Confirmation of membership of the General Teaching Council (GTCNI)
- Minimum of 2 years' continuous experience, teaching the Northern Ireland curriculum in a Key Stage 2 class, post qualification, in a paid capacity, within the last 4 years\*.
- Demonstrate a commitment to integrated, inclusive, all-ability and child centred education.
- Experience of coordinating the Eco Schools programme across the Key Stages.
- Minimum 1 years' experience implementing Accelerated Reader.
- Experience of working with children with learning and/or behavioural difficulties.
- Excellent interpersonal and intrapersonal skills and excellent oral and written communication skills.

#### **Enhanced Criteria**

- Qualified teacher status (as recognised by DENI) with a minimum of 1 years' continuous experience, in a paid capacity, of teaching a Primary 5 class within the last 4 years\*.
- Experience of working within the integrated sector and/or across partner schools i.e. integrated clusters, Shared Education Signature Project.
- Experience of using iPads and emerging technologies to positively impact learning and teaching.
- Experience of achieving Eco Schools Green Flag Awards.
- Experience of analysing data and using outcomes to set targets.
- Experience of improving learning outcomes for pupils with ASD, ADHD and Dyslexia.
- Willingness to take an after-school club.
- Experience of liaising with parents, staff and/or governors and external agencies.

+ *The successful applicant will teach a Key Stage 2 class initially. In order to meet the needs of the school, you may be required to teach other year groups.*
